
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Enforcement and Compliance

Summary

Data represent NOAA Fisheries Office of Law Enforcement Southeast Division's (OLE SED) enforcement effort conducted throughout Quarter 2 2018, January 1, 2018- March 31, 2018. When appropriate, information is separated by council, South Atlantic Fishery Management Council (SAFMC), Gulf of Mexico Fishery Management Council (GMFMC) and Caribbean Fishery Management Council (CFMC). There were **93** documented patrols, allowing critical face-to-face interaction between our field staff and the industry; **34** documented instances of outreach (not an exhaustive list; includes phone calls with industry, dock visits, trade shows, presentations, etc.); and **36** meetings. This list does not include the extensive outreach that the VMS team provides on a daily basis, nor can it fully capture the interaction our agents, officers, and support staff regularly have with industry.




Incident Information

During the second quarter, OLE opened **245** incidents in the SED, which included 287 incident violation counts- **162** incident violation counts in the SAFMC area and **140** incident violation counts in the GMFMC area¹.








Summary of Incidents by Law/Regulation/Program and State; Quarter 2 2018 (CFMC)

Enforcement Highlights

Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Management Act - Tortugas Shrimp Sanctuary

On January 18, 2018, NOAA OLE enforcement officers from St Petersburg, FL and the Florida Keys initiated an investigation during a joint patrol with USCG aboard the USCGC Raymond Evans. During the patrol, officers documented the FV RONALD E actively trawling inside the Tortugas Shrimp Sanctuary. The vessel was escorted back to port for further investigation. NOAA OLE enforcement officers ultimately seized the vessel's catch, which consisted of 6,173 pounds of Key West Pink Shrimp. The seized product was forfeited to the United States. This case is pending.

Endangered Species Act - Turtle Excluder Devises (TEDs)

On January 5, 2018, NOAA GCES issued a NOVA for \$66,000 to the owners/operator of the F/V JIMMY & JOHNNY for TED violations, which included TEDs that were sewn shut. The NOVA was issued as a result of an investigation worked by special agents in Slidell, LA and in partnership with USCG boarding officers who discovered the violations during an at sea boarding of the vessel.

On January 5, 2018, NOAA GCES issued a NOVA for \$9,000 to the owners/operator of the F/V MISS SALENA, for TEDs that were documented without the required flotation. The NOVA was issued as a result of an investigation worked by agents in Slidell, LA and in partnership with the Mississippi Department of Marine Resource's officers who documented the violations during an at sea boarding of the vessel.

Violations ranging from fishing in a closed area, improper gear use and failure to comply with reporting requirements (trip declarations, daily reports, pre-landing notices) were detected by VMS staff and referred to enforcement officers or special agents for follow-up. Additionally, the VMS staff conducted 266 calls with the industry relating to compliance during the quarter.

Significant VMS Issues:

SED Software Updates: Software for all vendors and vessels operating in the Catch Shares System, for reef fish, were updated to numeric VMS codes for dealer and landing locations. Outreach has been ongoing to assist with this upgrade.

Observer Program Highlights

During quarter 2 2018; the observer programs deployed on **98** trips for **872** sea days. Approximately **93%** of all selected trips were completed without an observer related enforcement incident (assault/harassment, safety). Effort conducted in the Gulf of Mexico consisted of observer coverage from the Galveston and Panama City Programs. The Gulf of Mexico Shrimp Program deployed on 21 trips for 428 sea days, and the Gulf of Mexico Reef Fish Program deployed on 15 trips for 74 sea days. The Panama City Gillnet Program deployed on 8 trips for 19 sea days, and the Panama City Bottom Longline Program (includes Shark Research Fishery) deployed on 31 trips for 38 sea days. The Pelagic Observer Program (POP) deployed on 23 trips for 313 sea days. The summary below details the status of observer related complaints during Quarter 2 of 2018, for all 3 programs.
