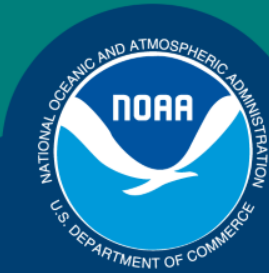

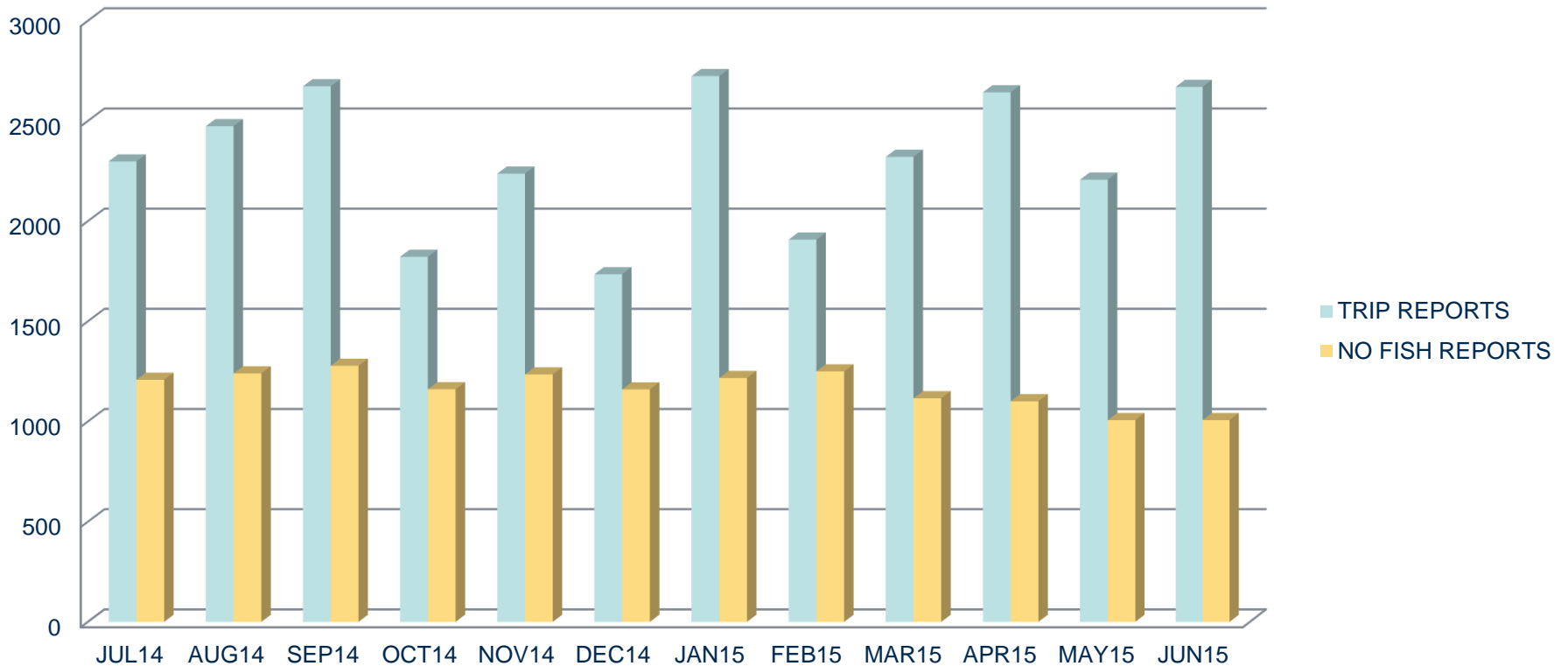

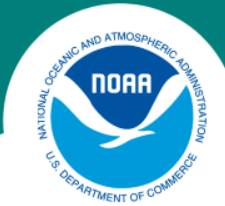

Commercial Vessel Logbook System 2014 - 2015

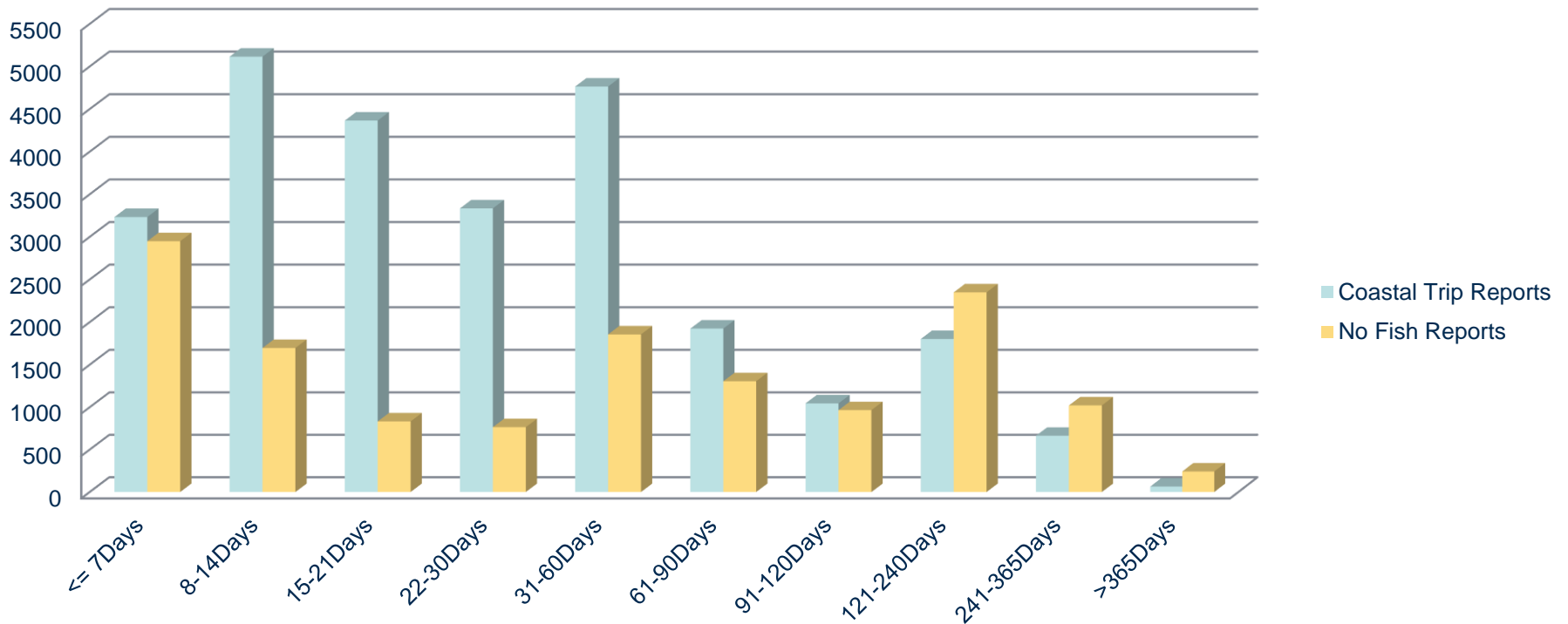
Counts of SAT Logbook Trip and No Fishing Reports Received by Month

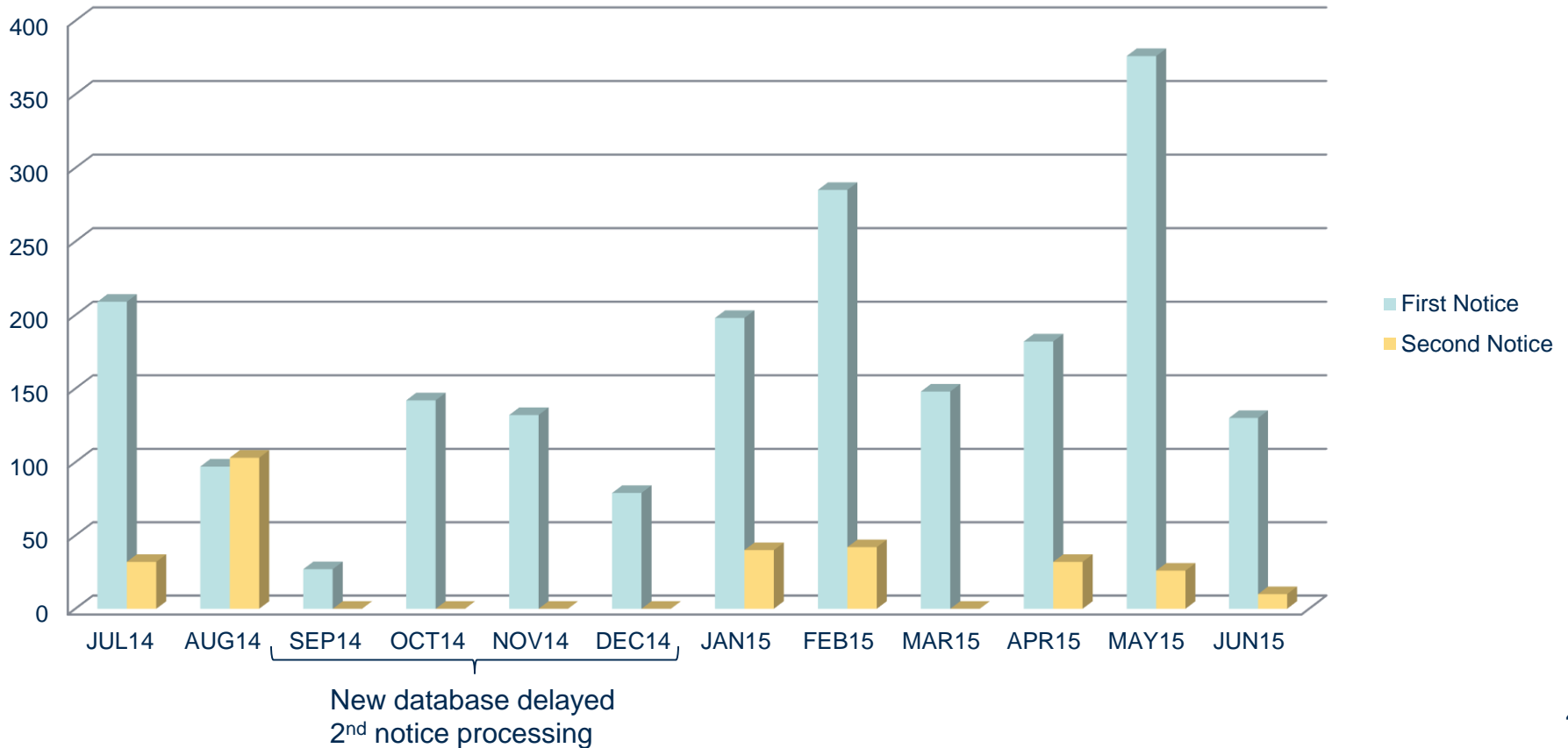
Counts of SAT Coastal Trip and No Fish Reports by Number of Days Reported After Trip Landing Date or End of Month for July 2014 through June 2015

Reporting non-compliance process

1. If no report during a month, then permit holder receives a letter from Permit Office at the time of renewal or transfer.
 - Permit is considered out of compliance and will not be renewed or transferred until reports are received for each month during permit active period.
2. If report has fatal errors, report is returned for correction.
 - Up to two notices (2 weeks and 4 weeks after report) will be sent by SEFSC.
 - Permit Office will send letter at time of renewal or transfer stating permit is out of compliance and cannot be renewed or transferred until corrected.
 - If report is not corrected, the report will not be available in master data used for analyses.
