

## **Purpose and Need**

- Increasing shift in the geographic distribution of fish stocks necessitates determination of the geographic scope of fisheries and which Council assumes responsibility for FMPs
  - Shift in authority from one Council to another
  - Managed jointly (e.g., Yellowtail Snapper with GMFMC)
- The policy provides guidance on four steps:
  - (1) determining whether to review the geographic scope of a fishery and/or the designation of Council authority;
  - (2) determining the geographic scope of the fishery;
  - (3) designation of Council authority under MSA § 304(f);
  - (4) guidance for transitioning management from existing Council(s), if needed
