South Atlantic Snapshot

- ≻ 193 Opened Incidents
- ➢ 7 Cases referred to General Counsel/US DOJ
- ➢ 37 Summary Settlements (\$275-\$2500)
 - Retention during closure/undersize possession
 - Descender Device Requirements
 - Permit Requirements, Fishing in Sanctuary
- Remaining were unfounded, boardings, fix-its, compliance assistance or WWs.
