Dear Secretary Lutnick:

On behalf of the eight U.S. Regional Fishery Management Councils, the Council Coordination Committee (CCC) respectfully requests that the full Fiscal Year (FY) 2025 Council Cooperative Agreement Award funding be made available to all Councils as soon as possible.

The Councils play a vital role in the sustainable management of our nation's fishery resources. We serve as a critical link between fishermen, small businesses, coastal communities, and NOAA Fisheries, helping to achieve the Administration's goals of economic growth, business and trade development, and increased availability of domestically sourced seafood.

Timely receipt of our full FY 2025 funding is essential for the Councils to carry out their participatory public processes that support access to fishing grounds, allocation of quotas, and the continued delivery of high-quality seafood to American consumers. We also request that this funding be aligned with the recent Cooperative Agreement Award renewal process to ensure continuity of operations, avoid disruption to Council and fishing industry activities, and support the productive harvest of our nation's seafood resources following recommendations from Executive Order 14276.
