# Commercial Landings Monitoring System Coastal Migratory Pelagic Species Reporting

- King mackerel, Spanish mackerel, and cobia are currently monitored “as reported”.
- Reported grades received since 2014 include:

- When data are reported to CLM, a product recovery rate (conversion factor) will be applied to the reported weight to estimate whole (round) weight. This is done for other fisheries with ACLs in whole or gutted condition and is an easy change in CLM.
