Setting ABCs for Spanish Mackerel

- Current ABC for Spanish Mackerel:
 - SEDAR 28 (2012)
 - ABC-CR: CMP Amendment 18 (2011)
 - Spanish Mackerel (2012): the SSC deviated from the ABC-CR and recommended using the 3rd highest landings from 1999 to 2008 as the ABC (NOTE: Spanish Mackerel current ABC is based on SEDAR 28 and is in MRIP-CHTS units)

SEDAR 78 Operational Assessment

- Revised assessment completed July 2022
- Methods guided by SEDAR 28 (2012)
- Not overfished: SSB₂₀₂₀/MSST = 1.4
- Not undergoing overfishing: $F_{2018-2020}/F_{msy} = 0.74$

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Setting ABCs

S78 Accepted

- Stock status from S78 assessment
- Apply ABC Control Rule
- ABC → determined from projections

S78 Partially Accepted

- Stock status from S78 assessment
- Deviate from ABC Control Rule
- ABC → alternate method:
 - 3rd highest landings
 - Equilibrium OY
 - Yield at 75%Fmsy
 - Others

S78 Rejected

- Stock status to be determined, possibly becomes 'unknown'
- NOAA-NMFS
 Procedure 01-101-11
- Deviate from ABC Control Rule
- ABC → alternate method
