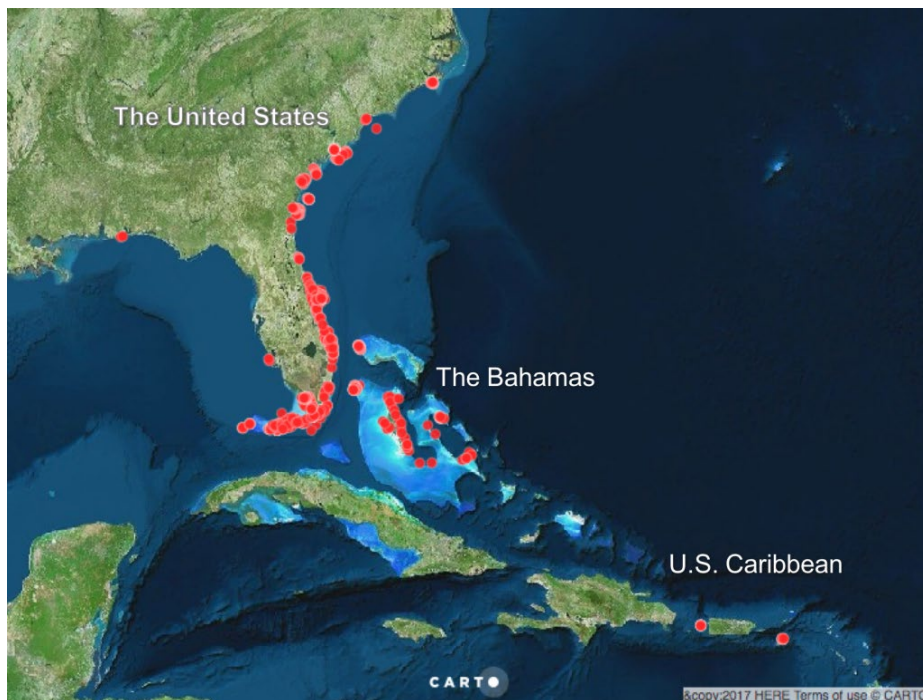


FACT Network <https://secoora.org/fact/>

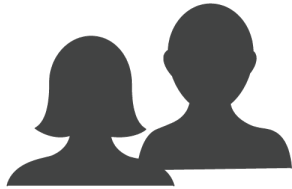


Our Purpose
