(b) The use of black sea bass pots is prohibited annually from November 1 through April 30.
(c) NOAA Fisheries has removed blueline tilefish from the Deep-water Complex. This rule became effective on March 30, 2015. Additionally, there is now a trip limit of 100 lbs gutted weight for commercial harvest of blueline tilefish.
(d) The 2015 landings of blueline tilefish represent 95.81% of the previous ACL of 112,207 lbs ww.
(e) Deepwater Complex: yellowedge grouper, silk snapper, misty grouper, queen snapper, sand tilefish, black snapper, blackfin snapper
(f) Grunts: White grunt, margate, sailor's choice, tomtate
(g) Jacks: Almaco jack, banded rudderfish, lesser amberjack
(h) During May and June, possession limited to 10 per person per day or per trip, whichever is more restrictive.
