A conflict of interest occurs when financial or other interests have the potential to influence scientific objectivity and professional judgment. Any use of an individual's appointment to a SEDAR workshop panel for financial or personal gain is considered a conflict of interest. Conflicts exist whenever there is a potential for perceived bias, even if the ultimate decisions and recommendations of an individual are not affected by such bias. For purposes of this disclosure, the term "conflict of interest" means any financial or other interest which conflicts with the service of the individual on the review panel because it (1) could significantly impair the individual's objectivity or (2) could create an unfair competitive advantage for any person or organization.

The goal of the Council in establishing this form is to ensure disclosure of potential financial and other interests that could be perceived as producing a conflict. Identification of a conflict of interest does not preclude an individual from SEDAR appointment.

This form is to be completed by SEDAR workshop appointment candidates who are not active AP or SSC members; employees of NOAA; employees of the marine fisheries management agencies of the states of NC, SC, GA, and FL; or employees of the Interstate Fisheries Management Commissions or ACCSP.
