Southeast Data, Assessment, and Review

Data Stage

- Data are compiled, reviewed, evaluated
- Participants include state, agency and university researchers, data collectors, analysts, SSC, and fishermen


Assessment Stage

- Assessment models are developed and refined
- Participants include analysts, SSC, and fishermen

Review Stage

- Independent peer review of data, model, and findings
- Reviewers include SSC and CIE representatives
 - Center for Independent Experts outside, independent scientists
- Participants also include analysts and fishermen






Fishermen Participation in SEDAR

- Fishermen appointed to SEDAR projects by Cooperator
 - SAFMC: To be appointed, must be on Advisory Panel or SEDAR Pool
 - Can be appointed to one stage or all stages
 - If appointed, SEDAR will pay for your travel & per diem
- Time commitment dependent on which stage(s) appointed
 - Each stage typically has workshop (3-5 days) and/or series of webinars
- What would I actually have to do?
 - Commit your time to attend the workshop and/or webinars
 - Share your knowledge of the fishery, review information, ask questions
- All SEDAR meetings are open to the public!






SEDAR 58 Atlantic Cobia Assessment

- Cobia Stock ID Process held in advance of assessment
- Multi-step Stock ID Process includes:
 - Stock ID Workshop: Apr 10-12, 2018
 - Stock ID Review Workshop: June 5-7, 2018
 - Joint Cooperator Technical Review: late July/Aug 2018
 - Science & Management Leadership Call: Aug 2018
 - FINAL STOCK ID RESOLVED: end of August 2018





SEDAR 58 Atlantic Cobia Assessment

- Planning underway for remaining stages of assessment (data, assessment, and review)
- Tentative schedule has assessment complete late 2019 - mid-2020
