32	Notes:	1. Two amendment leads or 1 lead plus the social/economic analyses on non-lead amendments is a full load for each staff person.														
33		Need to build in some time to address new methods for analyzing impacts and for special topics that may surface.														
34		2. The Council could be addressing up to 10 amendments at each meeting; this is more than a full load for the Council.														
35		3. In general, Amendment = 4 quarters, Reg Amendment 3 quarters														
36		4. Coral/Shrimp - looking at allowable fishing areas for rock shrimp & modifying the areas for golden crab.														
37		5. New assessment results for red grouper @ June 2017 Council meeting; will require Reg Am to make these changes.														
38		6. New assessment results for blueline tilefish @ June 2018 Council meeting; will require Reg Am to make these changes.
