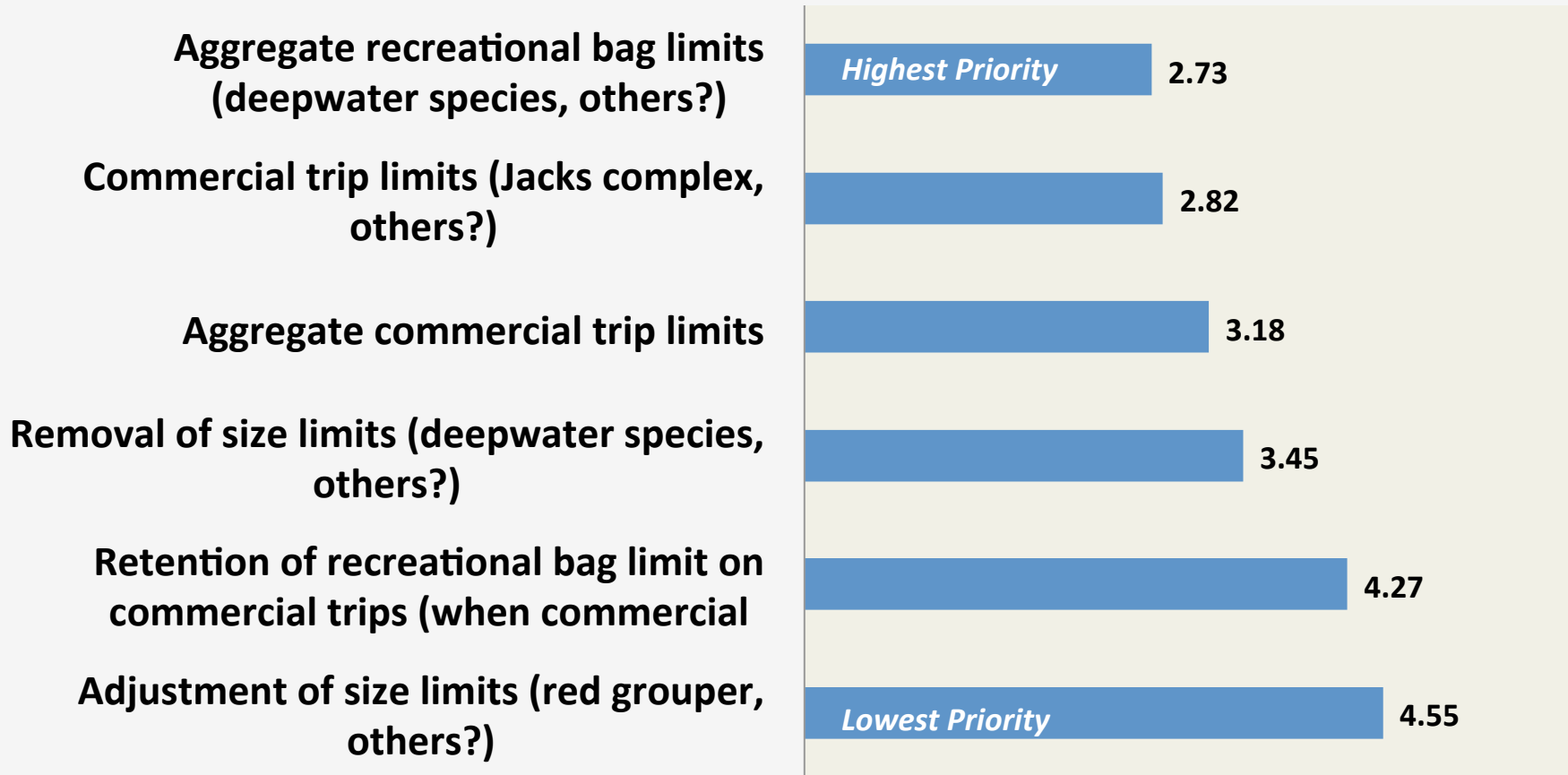


# Visioning Amendment – Survey Results

<b>Commercial trip limit for Jacks Complex</b>	<b>SERO did some trip limit analyses for the Complex with and without greater amberjack.</b>
<b>Black sea bass bag limit</b>	<b>Moved to Regulatory Amendment 25</b>
