MR. STARLING: My name is Lee Starling; I am a commercial fisherman. I have fished this area for 30 years; and as a diver I feel I have a unique and different view of what is going on in the water. Do you guys want to drop these schoolmasters and stuff? MR. HUNT: The South Atlantic Council is proposing to turn the fishery management of some of those snapper species over to the commission.

MR. STARLING: As far as handing those fish over to the FWC for management, I don't have a problem with that as long as those fish remain as restricted species and do not go into what I would call the Salt Water Products License without the restricted species, because it has those users. The Salt Water Products License has been abused to a great extent and has resulted in a huge decline in our barracuda and other stocks, because basically they don't regulate the SPL stringently enough.

MR. HUNT: I want to try to clarify that just because I don't know if the council understands restricted species. The state of Florida has a class of fish that require an extra level of commercial involvement; and it is called the Restricted Species Endorsement. That is what Lee is recommending.

MR. STARLING: Yes, I want those species to remain as a restricted species; because I find that fish that are not on the restricted species list, the license is only fifty dollars for that SPL, and it is abused.
