1. ABC Control Rule Amendment – (Attachment 1)

Description: The ABC Control Rule Amendment will revise and update the SAFMC ABC Control Rule (CR) and address recreational accountability measures. The purpose of the CR revisions is to address inconsistencies in the existing rule, outdated provisions, and MSA flexibility. The purpose of the accountability measures modifications is to address recreational data uncertainty and inconsistences across FMPs. During the webinar meeting held November 6, 2017, the Council recommended developing these actions as a comprehensive amendment, amending the Snapper Grouper, Coastal Migratory Pelagics, Spiny Lobster, Golden Crab, and Deepwater Shrimp FMPs.

The Council reviewed CR actions during a webinar on November 6, 2017. Recommendations from that meeting are included in the discussion document version provided for this meeting (**Attachment 1**)

Amendment Status: Under Development. Next steps include convening an IPT and developing a project work plan, including a schedule and task assignments. Members have been requested, and a first meeting will likely be held in early 2018. A first goal for the IPT is to develop a purpose and need statement for consideration by the Committee in March 2018.
