The information and data you provided through MyFishCount were considered by the National Marine Fisheries Service in order to extend the 2017 red snapper mini-season into December. The 2017 red snapper mini-season will be open on December 8, 9, and 10.

Your participation in MyFishCount was essential in the reopening of this fishery by providing information not previously captured by current monitoring programs. MyFishCount.com will remain open for the December mini-season weekend, and we encourage you and your fellow anglers to continue reporting. From your initial feedback, we were able to add additional features to the MyFishCount to facilitate the ease and timeliness of reporting.

Quick Log – Feature allows users to quickly log if a fish was kept or released and enter catch details later.

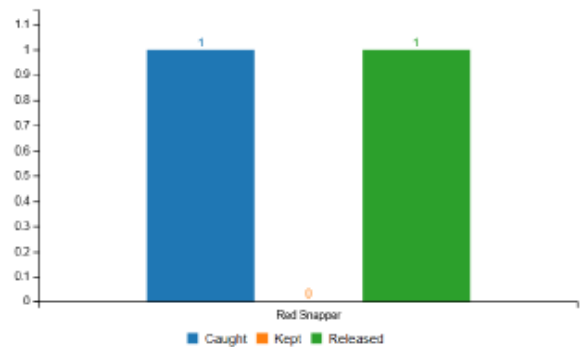
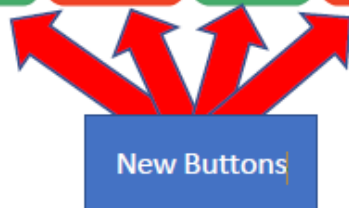
Your Catch Summary

Below is a log for each red snapper you reported and a personal map of catch location. It will have details on kept and released red snapper.

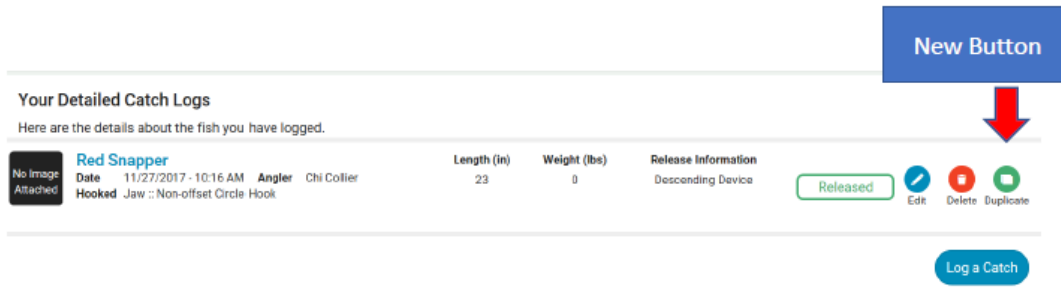


Log a Catch
