OVERVIEW

Snapper Grouper Recreational Permitting and Reporting Technical Advisory Panel

After introductions, the advisory panel (AP) will approve the agenda for the August 2023 meeting. This will be followed by an opportunity for public comment.

1. Comment on potential Council actions in Snapper Grouper Amendment 46 (Private Recreational Permitting) (Attachments 1a - 1d)

Description: Amendment 46 considers establishing a private recreational permit and education component for the South Atlantic snapper grouper fishery. Of note is that reporting is <u>not</u> being considered in this amendment. The Council has developed the amendment over several meetings after receiving input from three meetings of the Snapper Grouper Recreational Permitting and Reporting Technical Advisory Panel (AP).

The amendment examines permitting actions that would: 1) Establish a permit and specify whether a permit should be issued to a vessel or angler, 2) Specify the snapper grouper species that would be covered by the permit, 3) Specify the length of time that a permit would remain valid, and 4) Establish a mechanism that would allow a state to opt out of a federal permit requirement.

For the education component, the amendment includes actions that would: 1) Establish an education component, 2) Specify whether the education component is mandatory or voluntary, 3) Specify the timing of implementation for the education component, and 4) Specify the length of time that the education component would remain valid.

Requested AP action: Council staff will review a discussion document to help gather the AP's additional comments and recommendations on the actions that are being considered.
