

Commercial

1. Forms from trips landing between Sunday and Saturday must be submitted to the SRD by 11:59 P.M. local time on the following Tuesday.
2. SEFSC to SERO on Friday.
3. SERO updates webpage on Monday at the latest.

Private Recreational

1. Preliminary estimates of catch, effort, and participation are available approximately 45 days following the end of a sampling wave.
2. SEFSC recalculates pounds and provides to SERO within 15 days of estimates being released.
3. SERO updates webpage 3 business days or less.

Headboat

1. Electronic fishing records must be submitted at weekly intervals (or intervals shorter than a week if notified by the SRD) by 11:59 p.m., local time, the Sunday following a reporting week.
2. SEFSC provides to SERO within 15 days of receiving the estimates. SRHS releases wave estimates on the same time frame as MRIP.
3. SERO updates webpage by 3 business days or less.

Revisions to headboat and charterboat reporting are proposed in the for-hire amendment.
