(g) During May and June, possession limited to 10 per person per day or per trip, whichever is more restrictive.
(h) Porgies: Jolthoad, knobbed, saucereye, whitebone, scup
(j) Shallow Water Grouper: Red hind, rock hind, coney, graysby, yellowfin grouper, yellowmouth grouper
(j) Snappers: Gray, lane, cubera, dog, mahogany
(k) Each cobia is reported in the unit in which it is landed (either gutted or whole).

⁽a) Commercial harvest is prohibited during January 1-April 30 of each year.
(b) The use of black sea bass pots is prohibited annually from November 1 through April 30.
(c) NOAA Fisheries has removed blueline tilefish from the Deep-water Complex. This rule became effective on March 30, 2015. Additionally, there is now a trip limit of 100 lbs gutted weight for commercial harvest of blueline tilefish.
