- yellowfin grouper, yellowmouth grouper
- (k) Snappers: Gray, lane, cubera, dog, mahogany
- (1) Each cobia is reported in the unit in which it is landed (either gutted or whole).

⁽a) Commercial harvest is prohibited during January 1-April 30 of each year.

⁽b) The use of black sea bass pots is prohibited annually from November 1 through April 30.

⁽c) NOAA Fisheries has removed blueline tilefish from the Deep-water Complex. This rule became effective on March 30, 2015. Additionally, there is now a trip limit of 100 lbs gutted weight for commercial harvest of blueline tilefish.

⁽d) The 2015 landings of blueline tilefish represent 68.39 % of the previous ACL of 112,207 lbs ww.

⁽e) Deepwater Complex: yellowedge grouper, silk snapper, misty grouper, queen snapper, sand tilefish, black snapper, blackfin snapper
