SUBJECT: Preliminary 2011-2013 Commercial Landings

The Southeast Fisheries Science Center has provided the following **preliminary landings estimates** for species in the South Atlantic Fishery Management Council's area of jurisdiction subject to quota management through December 31, 2012, which includes electronically reported landings through April 19, 2012. This report reflects new quotas for king mackerel and Spanish mackerel implemented through Amendment 18 to the Fishery Management Plan for Coastal Migratory Pelagic Resources in the Gulf of Mexico and South Atlantic Region. The report also reflects the new quotas established for wreckfish and dolphin through the Comprehensive Annual Catch Limit Amendment.

b. Atlantic Spanish mackerel quota (%) listed is based on the 3,130,000-lb quota. Based on the adjusted quota of 2,880,000 lbs, the quota % is 9.39%.
c. Based on projections from the Southeast Fishery Science Center indicating the trip limit reduction for golden tilefish was surpassed, commercial harvest closed on February 17, 2012.
d. Commercial fishing for black sea bass closed on July 15, 2011.
