The commercial fishery for black sea bass closed on December 20, 2009.

Vermilion snapper closed on March 19, 2010.

Confidential landings

Given the early closure on the Gulf king mackerel Eastern Zone-East Coast subzone on February 4, 2010, the National Marine Fisheries Service reopened the fishery from March 3-7, 2010.

The trip limit for golden tilefish was reduced to 300 lbs gutted weight on March 18, 2010, and the fishery closed on April 12, 2010.

The Dolphin Wahoo Fishery Management Plan established a 1.5 million pound cap for the dolphin commercial fishery for both northeast and southern Atlantic regions. During January 1 through February 25, 2010, 0.61% of the 1.5 million-pound cap was landed (9,099

Octocoral landings are reported twice a year with final landings reported by May of the next year; therefore, these are the total landings for both Atlantic (81 trips) and Gulf (110 trips) in federal waters for 2009, reported in number of colonies.
