Atlantic king and Spanish mackerel data includes preliminary landings through February 3, 2010, and December 15, 2009, respectively.

Atlantic Spanish mackerel Quota (%) is based on the adjusted quota of 3,620,000 lbs.

The commercial fishery for black sea bass closed on December 20, 2009.

Confidential landings

Octocoral landings are reported twice a year with final landings reported by May of the next year, therefore, these are the total landings for both Atlantic (55 trips) and Gulf (105 trips) in federal waters for 2009, reported in number of colonies.



The Gulf king mackerel Eastern Zone-East Coast subzone quota was met and closed on February 4, 2010.

The Dolphin Wahoo Fishery Management Plan established a 1.5 million pound cap for the dolphin commercial fishery for both northeast and southern Atlantic regions.
