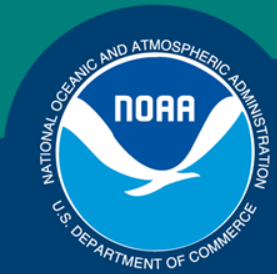

Headboat Survey Update June 2013



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Headboat Survey Updates since February:

- **The Southeast Region Headboat Survey (SRHS) continues to collect logbook data electronically in both South Atlantic & Gulf of Mexico.**
- **Since January 1, 2013, headboat captains can submit trip reports through secure website & mobile apps using personal computers, tablets or smart phones.**
- **Feedback have so far been generally positive.**



Headboat Survey Updates since February (continued):

- **2012 estimated headboat landings & angler days for both South Atlantic & Gulf of Mexico completed by March 7, 2013 ahead of schedule due to increased reporting & efficiency of logbook processing.**
- **Staff participated in SEDAR 32 Data Workshop. Headboat data has been used to create an index of abundance for gray triggerfish & blueline tilefish in the South Atlantic & is currently being considered for use in assessment model.**
