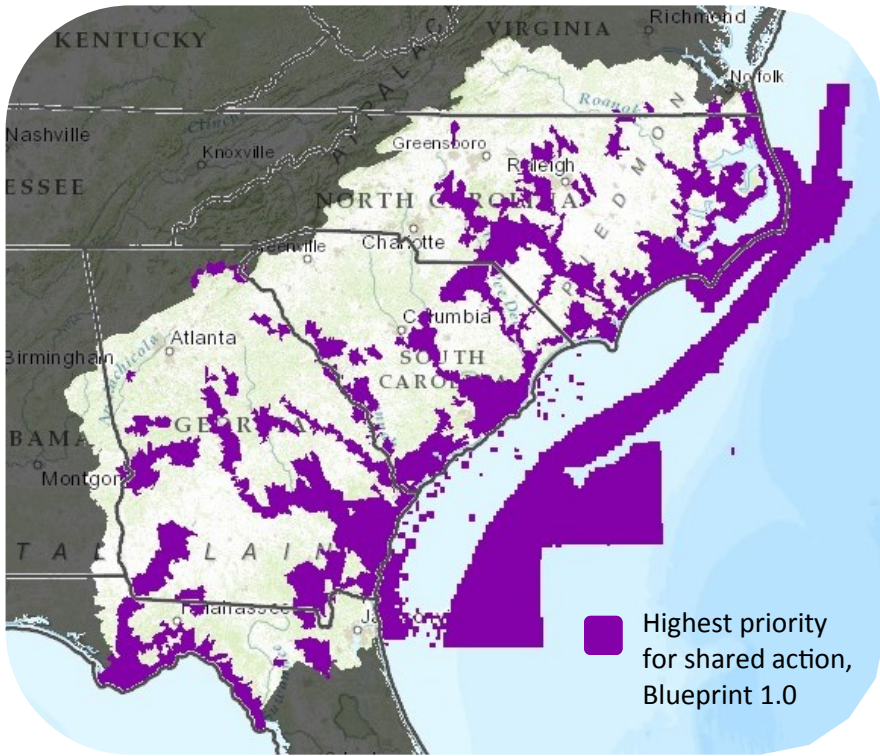

...measures success using natural and cultural resource indicators for terrestrial, freshwater, and marine ecosystems.

...applies sea level rise and urbanization models to consider adaptation to future threats.
