# **OVERVIEW** Citizen Science Committee

The Committee will review and approve the minutes from the December 2019 Citizen Science Committee meeting and the agenda for June 2020 meeting.

#### 1. Citizen Science Program Evaluation (Attachments 1a and 1b)

**Description**: To develop an evaluation plan, a program needs to have clear, agreed upon goals, objectives, and indicators of success. Over the past several months, the Citizen Science Operations (Ops) Committee has been working with Rick Bonney (Cornell Lab of Ornithology) and Jennifer Shirk (Citizen Science Association) to develop the Program Planning document (*Attachment 1a*). The Citizen Science Ops Committee agreed upon the following definitions of terms for this document:

- Goals are lofty and visionary.
- Objectives are specific and measurable steps of action that can be taken to achieve goals.
- Strategies are steps to meet objectives.
- Indicators are measures that show objectives have been reached.
  - Outputs are direct products of activities and easier to measure.
    - Outcomes are changes to individuals, groups, and/or communities because of participation or experience and are more challenging to measure.

Attachment 1b provides an overview of the Citizen Science Ops Committee's efforts in developing the Planning document. The Ops Committee has developed draft Program goals, objectives, strategies, and output indicators for the Committee's review and feedback. In the upcoming months, they will meet to draft desired Program outcomes which will come back to this Committee for review.

Additionally, Rick Bonney will share examples of outcomes or summative evaluation from other citizen science projects as illustrations of the kinds of evidence for increases in knowledge or changes in attitude that can be measured among program participants.

**Required Committee Action**: Review and provide feedback on Program Planning document (*Attachment 1a*). Provide guidance and recommendations on evaluation plan, as needed.
