Re: Additional Information on VMS referenced in Coral Amendment 10

Two additional maps have been prepared to support discussion and the rock shrimp Vessel Monitoring System (VMS) data presented in Coral Amendment 10. Below are links to two maps which combined show the footprint of the rock shrimp vessel operations on the eastern and western sides of the northern extension of the OHAPC and VMS points in the OHAPC and the proposed SFAA Preferred Alternative 2. Due to the confidential nature of the information, the VMS data presented includes all recorded points not just fishing activity. The actual non-confidential representation of the VMS data is presented in **Table 2.1.1** in Coral Amendment 10.


