The agenda was adopted, and the minutes of the September 2013 meeting were approved.

Joint Gulf & South Atlantic Council Generic Dealer Amendment

Dr. Jack McGovern reported that the amendment was sent to NMFS for formal Secretarial review on 9/26/13. The proposed rule package is under review in the Region and is expected to be submitted to headquarters soon.

Joint South Atlantic & Gulf Council Generic For-Hire Reporting Amendment (SA only)

Dr. Jack McGovern reported that the amendment was sent to NMFS for Secretarial review on 4/23/13. The Notice of Availability of the amendment was published in the Federal Register on 9/18/13, and comments were accepted through 11/18/13. The proposed rule published on September 18, and the comment period ended on 11/18/13. Decision day is 12/18/13.

Gulf Framework to implement For-Hire Reporting (Headboat only)

Dr. Jack McGovern reported that the amendment was sent to NMFS for Secretarial review on 7/18/13. The proposed rule published on October 25, and the comment period ended on 11/25/13. The final rule package is under review in the region.

Comprehensive Ecosystem-Based Amendment 3 (CE-BA3)

Anna Martin reviewed the Council's motions from the March 2013 meeting requesting a presentation from NOAA GC and stated that the presentation has been rescheduled for the March 2014 Council meeting.

<u>Update on Commercial Logbook Pilot Study</u>

Dr. Bonnie Ponwith updated the committee on the status of this project and delays resulting from the recent government closure. The SEFSC is still aiming for full implementation of the project during 2016 depending on funding.

Joint South Atlantic & Gulf Council Generic Charterboat Reporting Amendment

Council staff reviewed the status of work on the sub-committee to work on the technical issues related to this amendment, the Councils' intent, and the need for additional members of the committee that need to be appointed. The committee discussed the intent and clarified the direction to be provided to the technical group, and on behalf of the committee I move the following:

MOTION #1: The Councils' intent is to remove charterboats from the MRIP reporting system and have charterboats report catches electronically at a minimum of weekly as is being implemented for headboats. It is the Councils' intent that this information be updated on the SERO's website on some regular period.
