

**FINAL
SUMMARY REPORT
DATA COMMITTEE MEETING

The Data Committee received reports on CE-BA 3 and bycatch reporting, the SEFSC electronic commercial logbook pilot project and voluntary commercial logbook reporting, and discussed the charter reporting amendment.

MOTION #1. Move to recommend that the SEFSC conduct a cost analysis, considering agency and fishermen costs, on the set level electronic reporting program developed through the pilot project.
