SUMMARY REPORT FROM THE ECOSYSTEM BASED-MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE MEETING

St. Simons Island, GA March 7, 2011

The Ecosystem-Based Management Committee met on March 7, 2011 in St. Simon's Island, Georgia. The Committee was provided an overview of the public hearing comments received on Comprehensive Ecosystem-Based Amendment 2. The Committee discussed changes to the Comprehensive Ecosystem-Based Amendment 2, including development of additional alternatives, and selection of preferred alternatives for all actions. The Committee directed staff to further refine analysis in the document for final approval of Comprehensive Ecosystem-Based Amendment 2 during the June, 2011 Council meeting. An update on SAFMC activities pertaining to ecosystem-based management in the region was provided.

The Committee made the following motions:

MOTION #1. ADD ALTERNATIVE 3: MODIFY THE FMU TO INDICATE THAT OCTOCORALS ARE INCLUDED IN THE EEZ OFF NC, SC & GA APPROVED BY COMMITTEE

Action 1: Remove octocorals from the FMU under the South Atlantic Coral FMP

MOTION #2. MAKE ALTERNATIVE 3 OUR PREFERRED APPROVED BY COMMITTEE

Action 1: Alternative 3. Modify the FMU to indicate that octocorals are included in the EEZ off NC, SC & GA

MOTION #3. MAKE ALTERNATIVE 1 OUR PREFERRED APPROVED BY COMMITTEE

Action 2: Alternative 1. No Action. Do not extend the FMU for octocorals into the GMFMC's jurisdiction

MOTION #4. ADD ALTERNATIVE 3: ACL = 0 APPROVED BY COMMITTEE

Action 3: Modify the ACL for octocorals in the South Atlantic

MOTION #5. MAKE ALTERNATIVE 3 OUR PREFERRED APPROVED BY COMMITTEE

Action 3: Alternative 3. ACL = 0

MOTION #6. MAKE ALTERNATIVE 4 OUR PREFERRED APPROVED BY COMMITTEE

Note – This refers to Action 5, the IPT's revised Alternative 4, and selecting Sub-Alternative 4a and Sub-Alternative 4b as the Council's preferred.

IPT recommendation for revised Alternative 4:

Action 5: Alternative 4. Modify sea turtle and smalltooth sawfish release gear based on freeboard height. Fishermen would still be required to comply with all current sea turtle and smalltooth sawfish release guidelines. The design specifications of required gear and the handling and release techniques employed must comply with those described in the NOAA Fisheries Service document entitled "Careful Release Protocols for Sea Turtle Release with Minimal Injury."

Sub-Alternative 4a. Vessels with freeboard height of 4 feet or less would be required to carry and use:

- a short-handled dehooker for ingested hooks; or a dehooker for ingested and a dehooker for external hooks
- long-nose or needle-nose pliers,
- bolt-cutters
- mono-filament line cutters
- *cushion/support device (i.e., boat cushion)*
- a dipnet
- at least two types of mouth openers/mouth gags

Sub-Alternative 4b. Vessels with freeboard height of 4 feet or more (and/or using longline gear) would be required to carry and use:

- a long-handled line cutter,
- a long-handled dehooker for ingested hooks; or a dehooker for ingested and a dehooker for external hooks,
- a long-handled device to pull an "inverted V",
- a dipnet,
- cushion/support device (i.e., boat cushion)
- a short-handled dehooker for ingested hooks; or a dehooker for ingested and a dehooker for external hooks
- long-nose or needle-nose pliers,
- bolt cutters.
- monofilament line cutters, and
- at least two types of mouth openers/mouth gags.

MOTION #7. SELECT ALTERNATIVE 2 AS PREFERRED APPROVED BY COMMITTEE

Action 7: Alternative 2. Amend the Coral FMP to designate Deepwater Coral HAPCs as EFH-HAPCs.

MOTION #8. SELECT ALTERNATIVE 3 AS PREFERRED APPROVED BY COMMITTEE

Action 8: Alternative 3. Amend the Sargassum FMP to designate the top 10 meters of the water column in the South Atlantic EEZ bounded by the Gulfstream, as EFH for pelagic Sargassum.

MOTION #9. SELECT ALTERNATIVE 1 AS PREFERRED APPROVED BY COMMITTEE

Action 9: Alternative 1. No Action. Do not designate EFH-HAPCs for Pelagic Sargassum
