The Committee will: (A) receive an update from SEFSC on the status of catches versus quota for octocorals; (B) receive an update on the status of CE-BA 2; (C) review items for consideration in CE-BA 3; and (D) receive updates on coral and ecosystem-based activities.

Comprehensive Ecosystem-Based Amendments CE-BA 2

The Committee will receive an update on the status of CE-BA 2 since approval and submission of the document in June. The Gulf Council was provided an overview of CE-BA 2 actions that modify the CMP FMP, and the Committee will receive an update on their discussion. (Attachments 1&2)

CE-BA3

The Committee will review items for consideration in CE-BA 3, including:

- 1. Protective measures for speckled hind and warsaw grouper in the mid-shelf fishery
- 2. Powerhead prohibition in EEZ off NC
- 3. Potential expansion of HAPC areas
- 4. Consideration of expansion of Snowy Wreck MPA
- 5. Wreckfish fishery impacts to deepwater coral habitat
- 6. Impacts associated with deep dropping for other SG species

The intent is to develop a comprehensive list of measures and approve for scoping at the December 2011 meeting. Scoping meetings will be held during the last week in January and first week in February 2012.

REQUIRED COMMITTEE ACTION: Provide guidance to staff on addition of other items for consideration in CE-BA 3 at this time.

Ecosystem Coordination Updates
