ECOSYSTEM-BASED MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE CHARLESTON, SC SEPTEMBER 14, 2010

The Ecosystem-Based Management Committee convened on Tuesday, September 14, 2010. The Committee received a report from SSC Chair, Dr. Carolyn Belcher; discussed changes to the Comprehensive Ecosystem-Based Amendment 2, including proposed EFH and EFH-HAPCs, and provided guidance to staff; provided guidance on actions pertaining to *Sargassum*; reviewed and approved the draft estuarine and marine invasive species policies; and received an update on SAFMC activities pertaining to ecosystem-based management in the region.

The committee made the following motions:

MOTION #1: COUNCIL REQUESTS THAT THE SEFSC PROVIDE TRENDS AND SAFE REPORTS ANNUALLY BY THE SEPTEMBER COUNCIL MEETING APPROVED BY COMMITTEE

Comprehensive Ecosystem-Based Amendment 2

MOTION #2: WITHDRAW ACTION 1-5 AND REPLACE WITH AN EXPLANATION APPROVED BY COMMITTEE

MOTION #3: THE COUNCIL'S INTENT IS THAT THE 50K COLONIES APPLY TO BOTH STATE AND FEDERAL WATERS
MOTION WITHDRAWN

Alternative 3. Limit harvest and possession of CMP species (with the use of all non-prohibited fishing gear) in South Carolina's Special Management Zones to the recreational bag limit.
