### 1. Council Coordination Committee update

Since the planned handbook discussion will not occur, staff will take this opportunity to provide some background on the "CCC" and request input on agenda topics for the next meeting (Attachment 1a).

The CCC closely monitors MSA reauthorization activities and maintains a working paper that provides CCC consensus and individual Council positions on likely legislative topics (Attachment 1b). The Council should consider reviewing its positions on current legislative topics over the next year.

The report from the last CCC meeting, held via webinar in October 2021, is provided (Attachment 1c). Ongoing activities include monitoring progress on guidelines to implement NEPA changes from 2020, National Standard 1 guidance memorandums, Environmental Justice initiatives, the Climate Crisis Executive Order, and MSA reauthorization.
