














Enhanced VMS reporting in closed area only-verify transit vs fishing activity

- ► Recreational Red Snapper
 - ➤ Open 12:01 a.m., local time, on July 11, 2025, through 12:01 a.m., local time, on July 13, 2025.
- > Recreational Blueline Tilefish
 - ➤ Closes July 22
- > Recreational Gag
 - ➤ Closes June 26
- ▶Bahamas Fishing
 - ➤ Declare in w/Bahamians
 - ➤ Single day vessel/per person bag limits
 - ➤ Transit on return-no stops
 - >Skin on fillets

NOAA Fisheries Office of Law Enforcement is seeking information in the death of a bottlenose dolphin and help identifying those responsible for decapitating the dolphin on or around April 17, 2025. The stranding of a then-intact dolphin was reported from Lea-Island, NC. When authorities arrived to document the stranding, they discovered the dolphin was missing its head.

A reward of up to \$20,000 may be paid for any information provided that leads to the successful issuance of a civil penalty or criminal conviction in this case.
