- ► Foreign Fishing Vessels Detected: 0
- ► Foreign Fishing Vessels Intercepted: 0
- ► Foreign Fishing Vessels Interdicted: 0
  - ▶ <u>Summary</u>: There have been no US EEZ incursions within the last two quarters. This can be attributed to the increased presence in various threat vectors w/in the Area of Responsibility.


# Marine Protected Resources Enforcement
