OVERVIEW Full Council Session I

1. Reports (Attachments 1a and 1b)

Description: NOAA Office of Law Enforcement, US Coast Guard, state agencies, and Council liaisons will provide reports to the Council.

2. Acceptable Biological Catch Control Rule Amendment (Attachments 2a and 2b)

Description: The Council discussed this amendment most recently in September 2021 and provided guidance on development to staff. The SSC reviewed topics related to this amendment most recently in October 2021. Staff will present the most recent actions and alternatives language drafted by the IPT concerning the acceptable biological catch (ABC) control rule (with focus on the stock risk rating), carry-overs, and revisions to framework procedures. The SSC Chair will provide SSC recommendations on ABC control rule alternatives, including the stock risk rating.

Required Council Action: Discuss the potential stock risk rating process and use, as well as clarify how implementation of carry-overs should be considered through framework procedures.

3. Allocations Decision Tool Review (Attachments 3a and 3b)

Description: Making sector allocation decisions is a difficult and complicated process. To help the Council incorporate other sources of information, in addition to landings, when making sector allocations decisions, staff developed a Decision Tree Approach and presented the most up-to-date draft to the Council in February 2022. Staff also presented an example of how to apply the approach to a managed species (greater amberjack). At this meeting, the Council will have the opportunity to discuss how they envision using the approach moving forward and provide this guidance to staff.

Required Council Action: Discuss how the Allocations Decision Tool will be used in the future to inform allocation decisions thorough the fishery management plan amendment process.
