Objective and Goal for this Advance Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (ANPR)



Objective Determine if updates to the Guidelines for National Standards 4, 8, and 9 are needed to improve fisheries management.

Goal:Solicit public input on the current guidelines: areas/issues that may benefit from further consideratio and/or revisions, as appropriate.



Background

MSA National Standards:

- NS 4 <u>allocations</u> hall: be fair and equitable; promote conservation; not result in excessive shares.
- NS 8 consider impacts to **communities** provide for sustained participation; minimize adverse economic impacts to the extent practicable.
- NS 9 minimize **bycatch** and bycatch mortality, to the extent practicable.

- ClimateRelated Impacts on Fisheries
- Promoting Equity and Environmental Justice in Fisheries

NS4 (Allocation) Guidelines: Climate Issues

We request specific input on:

- Approaches for balancing access for:
 - historical users,
 - marginalized individuals who may have inequitably excluded historically, and
 - new users



- If revisions are needed to reinforce the NMFS Allocation Policy
- Types of documentation, analyses, or alternative approaches that be considered.



NS8 (Communities) & NS9 (Bycatch) Guidelines: Climate

We request specific input on:

 NS8-updating the guidelines to improve the a of communities to adapt to changing condition

 NS9-updating the guidelines to better accounchanging distributions of target stocks, bycatch, and protected resources.



NS4 (Allocation) Guidelines: Equity and Environmental J

We request specific input on:

- Approaches to improve consideration c
 - underserved/underrepresented communities
 - previously excluded entrants
 - new entrants

 Types of documentation and analyses that could help ensure allocations are fair and equitable



NS8 (Community) Guidelines: Equity and Environmental

We request specific input on:

 If the definition of "fishing community" the guidelines should be updated:

 to allow communities that are not based (i.e., fishery participants are required to live in same geographic location)



NS8 (Community) Guidelines: Equity and Environmental Continued...

We request specific input on:

 If the definition of "fishing commu within the guidelines should be up

 to shift balance between dependence and engagement



NS8 (Community) Guidelines: Equity & Environmental Just Continued...

We request specific input on:

- How to appropriately balance requirement "sustained participation" of fishing communities with the need to improve consideration of:
 - underserved/underrepresented communities
 - previously excluded entrants
 - new entrants
 - communities with high levels of social or climate vulnerabilities



NS9 (Bycatch) Guidelines: Equity and Environmental Just

We request specific input on how/whether to:

 Modify guidelines to minimize bycatch in manner that is equitable across different fisheries and gear types

 Better balance needs of bycatch and target fisheries in a matter that is equitable acredifferent fisheries and gear types, especially when one or more fisheries are important for underserved populations.



Other Challenges Mentioned in ANPR

NMFS is also requesting comments on:

- Options for minimizing bycatch under the NS9 practicability stand
- Revisions to the guidelines that would incentivize reducing waste











Timeline:

ANPR

- Published May 15, 2023
- Presentation to CCC May 23, 2023
- Presentations offered to each Council June-August 2023
- Two Tribal and One National Level Webinar June-July 2023
- Public comment period closes September 12, 2023

If warranted, NMFS will begin drafting a proposed rule in Fall of 2023
