Commercial ACL overages in 2020

Atlantic cobia	135.5%	11/6/20
Golden tilefish (H&L)	105.6%	7/23/20
Golden tilefish (LL)	103.1%	2/18/20; Reopened 3/14-3/23/20
Gray triggerfish	100.6%	11/29/20
Red snapper	107.7%	9/5/20
Snowy grouper	100.5%	12/12/20
Spanish mackerel (NZ)	135.7%	7/22/20
Spanish mackerel (SZ)	118%	2/3/21
Spanish mackerel (total)	121.5%	



Commercial AMs

- In-season closure
- Post-season: Reduce the commercial ACL for the following fishing year by the amount of the commercial ACL overage in the prior fishing year if
 - The commercial ACL is exceeded,
 - The total ACL is exceeded, and
 - And overfished

*red snapper does not have a payback AM

Since all three criteria did not apply to the stocks with the payback AM in 2020, no commercial paybacks will be applied in 2021.



Recreational overages in 2020

Blueline tilefish	336%	-87% of 2020 landings in wave 4 (July/Aug) -78% of wave 4 landings came from Nags Head, NC -90% of Nags Head harvest in wave 4 came from Charter mode -73 intercepts in NC -PSE=62% for wave 4
Golden tilefish	125%	Rec. ACL=2,316 fish
Red snapper	144%	MRIP for states other than FL. GA survey for charter.



Recreational AMs

- In-season closure
- Post-season: to reduce the length of the recreational fishing season and the recreational ACL by the amount of the recreational ACL overage if
 - The recreational ACL is exceeded,
 - The total ACL is exceeded, and
 - And overfished

*for red snapper, the length of the rec. season is the AM

Since all three criteria did not apply to the stocks with the payback AM in 2020, no recreational paybacks will be applied in 2021.
