Southeast For-Hire Integrated Electronic Reporting:

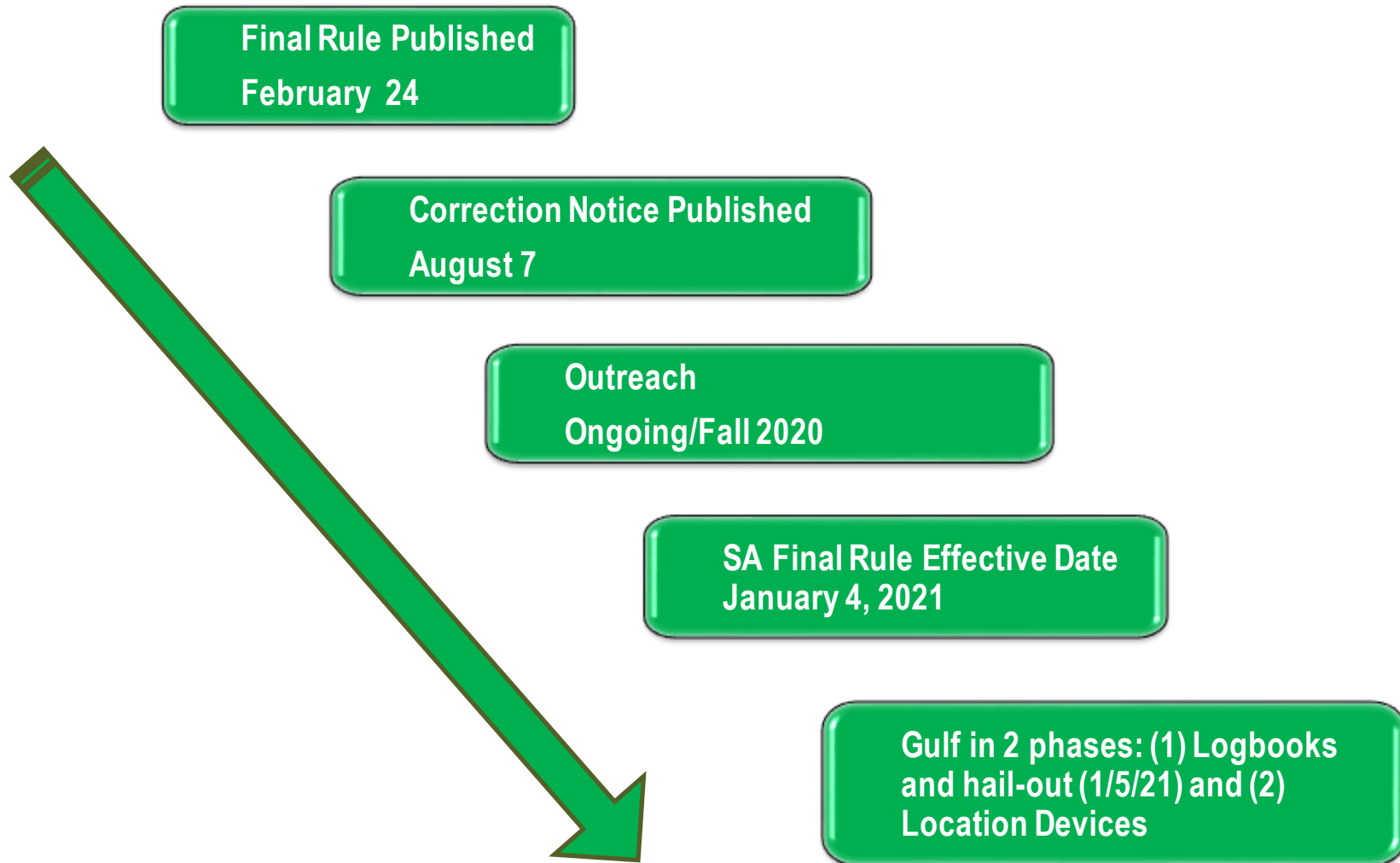
September 2020 Update

South Atlantic and Gulf Reporting Program

- Applies to all southeast federally permitted charter and headboats *regardless of where they are fishing*
- Requirements (applicable permit holders)
 - Trip-level logbooks (Gulf and South Atlantic)
 - Hail-out prior to leaving on any trip (Gulf)
 - Location tracking device (Gulf)
- Vessels with both permits
 - Must follow Gulf requirement *regardless of where they are fishing*



Projected Implementation Timeline



What are we working on?

- **Logbooks (Gulf and South Atlantic)/Hailout (Gulf)**
 - Software tech specs and approval process posted
 - We are currently testing eTrips and VESL software
 - Data warehouse – data security audit complete, approval in process
- **QA/QC protocols**
 - Procedures to direct us how to QA/QC the data
- **For-Hire Intercept Survey**
 - Collaboration between SEFHIER team, Office of Science and Technology, and Gulf States Commission
 - Gulf Survey expected to start early 2021
