Ms. Brouwer: Capt. Willie Howard here in West Palm Beach.

I have a federal dolphin/wahoo charter permit and participate in electronic reporting.

To improve the system:

- 1. Make the reporting app. more self-explanatory and faster to use, meaning captains would have to spend less time reporting. The areas fished such as "florida waters inshore" with a number are tricky to interpret. Captains should not have to take a class in your software to comply. Keep it simple.
- 2. Make more captains aware of the need for federal permits and electronic reporting. Most captains in this area don't want extra work and don't bother obtaining a permit, meaning SAFMC gets nothing from them... and they suffer no penalties, it seems, for not obtaining a permit. There is no incentive to comply.
- 3. The idea of making reporting more immediate is not practical. After my charters, I have to clean fish, clean the boat, etc. I often can't sit down at my iPad to report until the next day...or a few days later if I have back-to-back charters.
