1. Introduction

John Carmichael, Executive Director, will review the process for the meeting week.

2. Advisory Panel (AP) appointments (Attachment 1)

The Council will consider seats on the Dolphin Wahoo AP, Law Enforcement AP and the Outreach and Communications AP and draft recommendations.

3. AP policy (Attachment 2)

The Council will review AP Policy language currently included in the Council's Handbook addressing such topics as member termination and meeting attendance and discuss of options for inactive advisory panels, late applications and appointments, and other policy modifications as needed.

4. Mackerel Cobia AP composition (Attachment 3)

During its September 2020 meeting the Council reviewed appointments to the Mackerel Cobia AP and decided to further discuss the structure of the advisory panel during its December meeting. Currently, there are no state or sector specific seats on the AP except for a designated NGO seat. The Council discussed the need to ensure the AP is representative of the CMP fishery, including a representative for the Cobia fishery off the east coast of Florida.

Note: During the November 2020 Mackerel Cobia AP meeting, the AP also discussed the need to have representatives on the AP from the Mid-Atlantic and New England regions as participation in the fishery for King Mackerel and Spanish Mackerel increases further north.
