Coastal and Marine Spatial Planning Recommendations

- Include specific ecological, cultural and human use objectives in CMSP Strategic Action Plan
- Create databases needed for CMSP, prioritize gaps



- Provide technical and policy assistance to Regional Planning Bodies
- Consider employment, community needs, cultural heritage, tribal rights and regional cost benefit analyses in developing CMS plans

Land/Sea Interaction Recommendations

- To strengthen protection of marine resources that cross the land/sea interface:
 - Improve MPA information and tools;
 - Conduct research on land/sea interactions;
 - Strengthen management partnerships
 - Establish coastal/marine protected area networks;
 - Enhance outreach and public engagement



Cultural Heritage Resource Recommendations

- Adopt cultural heritage vision statement & Framework changes
- Strengthen cultural heritage governance practices, recognizing diverse approaches



- Improve cultural heritage information in MPA Inventory and representation in the National System
- Adopt a Cultural Landscape Approach
- Expand cultural heritage training for MPA managers

Healthy Coastal Communities Recommendations

Conservation and management are social processes, and MPAs are social institutions

To support healthy coastal communities:

•Use a set of guiding principles for entities developing and/or managing MPAs;

•Significantly increase the use of the social sciences by entities developing and managing MPAs; and



•Advocate for and/or support a national center of excellence for the social sciences of MPAs.
