Dear Mr. Strelcheck:

Below are items the South Atlantic Fishery Management Council is recommending in its Essential Fish Habitat (EFH) five-year review. In addition, please note the follow-up items that have occurred and are recommended to occur over the next five years.

- 1. Clarify the definition of mangroves and buttonwoods in the EFH User Guide.
  - a. The recommended definition has been integrated into the EFH User Guide.
  - b. Source: Buttonwood Clarification Subgroup Report
- 2. Include the North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources' coordinates for upstream tidal boundaries into the EFH User Guide as an upper boundary for EFH.

  - b. The tidal boundary table has been integrated into the EFH User Guide.
  - c. Source: Tidal Freshwater Boundary Subgroup Report
- 3. Update the Food Webs and Connectivity Policy information with improved prey information, improved food web information, and updated the reference information.
  - a. The working group identified the top 10 prey groups for each Fishery Management Plan by percentage by volume in diet in Appendix A.
  - b. The working group recommends further analysis of the information in Appendix A to identify:
    - i. Total importance of prey or percentage overlap across all FMPs
    - ii. The number of times prey species are identified as a top prey item
    - iii. The EFH by life stage of identified important prey
    - iv. Other indicators that a prey item is highly necessary to a species diet
  - c. The working group recommends investigating the integration of the habitat utilized by important prey species into the EFH User Guide for the next 5-year review.
