## 1. Presentation on modifying the commercial retention limit for blacknose sharks and non-blacknose small coastal sharks in the Atlantic Region (Attachment 1)

NMFS Highly Migratory Species (HMS) staff will give the HMS committee a presentation on a proposed rule to modify the commercial retention limit for blacknose and non-blacknose small coastal sharks in the Atlantic Region. This rule change will implement management measures for the commercial Atlantic small coastal shark fisheries intended to allow for the better utilization of available non-blacknose small coastal shark quota while also rebuilding and preventing overfishing of blacknose sharks. Public comment is currently being sought on the proposed rule and will be accepted through September 20, 2016.
