## 2. Best Fishing Practices Campaign Update – (Attachment 2)

**Description**: The Council recently approved Snapper Grouper Regulatory Amendment 29, which proposes measures that would require descending devices be on board and readily available for use on vessels fishing for or possessing snapper grouper species. The amendment also includes measures for circle hooks and powerheads. The Council directed staff to begin work on developing a best fishing practices outreach campaign. Council staff will update the Committee on the ongoing development of the campaign, including a draft webpage for the Committee's review. In addition, staff will provide updates on plans for future outreach efforts related to best fishing practices, highlighting potential partnerships with influential members of the fishing community.

Required Committee Action: Review and provide guidance to staff.
