SUBJECT: Preliminary 2008-2009 Commercial Landings

The Southeast Fisheries Science Center has provided the following **preliminary landings** estimates for species in the South Atlantic Fishery Management Council's area of jurisdiction subject to quota management through February 28, 2009.

e. The Dolphin Wahoo Fishery Management Plan established a 1.5 million pound cap for the dolphin commercial fishery. Data includes preliminary landings during January 1, 2008, through August 31, 2008.

f. Octocoral landings are reported twice a year with final landings reported by May of the next year; therefore, these are the total landings for both Atlantic (750 trips) and Gulf (87 trips) in federal waters for 2007, reported in number of colonies.
