# **OVERVIEW**

### Mackerel and Cobia Committee

The Committee will approve the minutes from the December 2023 meeting and the agenda for the March 2024 Committee meeting.

### • Law Enforcement Advisory Panel Report (*LE AP Report*)

**Description**: The Law Enforcement Advisory Panel met on January 29 and 30, 2024 in Charleston, South Carolina. The AP Chair, Captain Scott Pearce, will provide a summary of Advisory Panel discussion and recommendations on items relevant to the Coastal Migratory Pelagics fishery, namely the sale of tournament caught king and Spanish mackerel.

Committee Action: review Advisory Panel input and provide guidance to staff.

### 1. Mackerel Port Meetings (Attachment 1)

**Description**: Based on recommendations from the Mackerel Cobia Advisory Panel, the Council directed staff to begin work on a plan to conduct port meetings for king and Spanish mackerel to gain a comprehensive understanding of the fisheries to improve management efforts. At the December 2023 meeting, the Council reviewed and provided input on the draft port meeting structure and port meeting locations.
