OVERVIEW Mackerel and Cobia Committee

The Committee will approve minutes from June 2021 meeting and the agenda for the September 2021 Committee meeting.

 CMP Amendment 34 – Updates to king mackerel management based on SEDAR 38 Update 2020 – (*Attachments 1a* and 1b)
Description: At the June 2020 meeting the Council directed staff to begin work on an options paper that would include consideration of sector allocations and catch level adjustments based on SSC recommendations and the recent stock assessment update. At the March 2021 meeting, the Council approved actions and alternatives to be included in CMP Amendment 34 for analysis. Scoping for the amendment was also held during the public comment period associated with the March 2021 Council meeting. In June 2021, the Council reviewed the amendment and selected preferred alternatives for several actions. Council staff will review a decision document for CMP Amendment 34 for the Council to consider for public hearings. Additionally, Council state representatives will provide information on how Action 6 (damaged fish) may conflict with state regulations and their state regulatory process for modifying regulations.

Committee Action: review draft document, select preferred alternatives, and consider approval for public hearings.

2. CMP Amendment 32 – Updates to Gulf cobia management based on the SEDAR 28 Update 2020 and the CMP Framework Procedure – (*Attachments 2a* and 2b) Description: An update to SEDAR 28 assessment for Gulf cobia was completed in July 2020. The results indicate that Gulf cobia is undergoing overfishing, which puts the stock at risk of becoming overfished without management action. The Gulf SSC reviewed the results of the updated SEDAR 28 assessment and provided recommendations for new ABCs for Gulf cobia. At the March 2021 meeting, the Council reviewed actions and alternatives, selected preferred alternatives, and requested an additional action be added to the amendment to address sector allocations in the Florida east coast (FLEC) zone. In June 2021, the Council reviewed the amendment and selected preferred alternatives for several actions. The Gulf Council will review this amendment at their August meeting and consider approval for public hearings. Council staff will review a decision document and an updated draft document for CMP Amendment 32 for the Council to consider for public hearings.
