Attached you will find a document titled "Modifications to Charter Vessel and Headboat Reporting Requirements," a comprehensive amendment consisting of Amendment 39 to the Fishery Management Plan for the Snapper Grouper Fishery of the South Atlantic, Amendment 9 to the Fishery Management Plan for the Dolphin and Wahoo Fishery of the Atlantic, and Amendment 27 to the Fishery Management Plan for the Coastal Migratory Pelagics Fishery of the Gulf of Mexico and Atlantic Region.
