SA Chesler provided training to FL FWCC pilots on South Atlantic marine protected areas including the Oculina HAPC.

PATROL ACTIVITY HIGHLIGHTS:

- 1. The FL FWCC Patrol Vessel *C.T. Randall* patrolled a total of 32 hours this quarter, there were no vessels boarded.
- 2. USCG small boats and cutters conducted a total of 24 hours of patrol within the OHAPC during this quarter.
- 3. SA Chesler investigated two complaints of possible illegal fishing within the OHAPC based on Vessel Monitoring System tracks. Further investigation revealed that there were no violations and that the vessels were transiting the OHAPC with golden tilefish or royal red shrimp, respectively.
